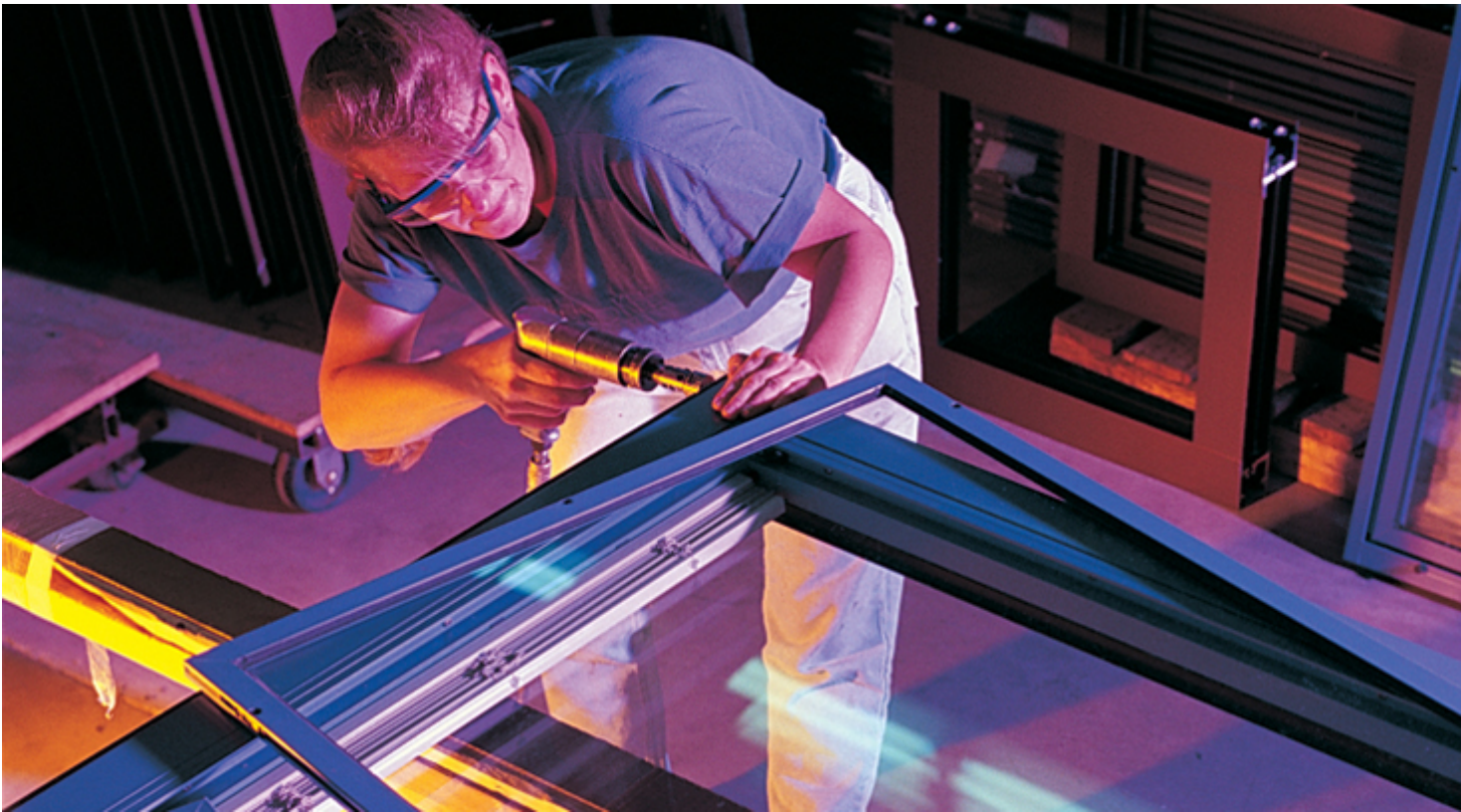




Local Economy
